Creativity Workshops









Handbuilding with Clay

Using air-dry clay, explore fundamental modelling techniques, form, line, and texture, starting with a simple pinch pot while exploring the history of Canadian Indigenous pottery. Then, using these techniques, design and model a textured clay animal sculpture. You will have two clay projects to keep.

Recommended for age 5+ Max 30

Mixed Media Watercolour

Using artist-grade materials, we will practice watercolour techniques, explore colour theory, and will observe the reactions between mediums. Then using mixed-media methods we will create your own composition.

Recommended for age 8+ Max 24



Printmaking 101

Using traditional tools like ink and brayers, create a scratch foam 'master plate' to make prints on colourful paper. Using elements such as line, shape, composition, and balance, we will explore symbolism and identity to create their own brand or logo.

Recommended for learners age 8+ Max 24



Expressive Self Portrait

Inspired by Canadian portrait artists and using artist-grade materials, explore how portraiture can express complex ideas about self, identity, and community. We will explore symbolic uses of colour and abstraction while creating a step-by-step self-portraits using oil pastel on paper.

STEAM Workshops

Paper Making

A favourite eco-craft! Have fun using recycling to make a your own custom art paper. Embed your paper creations with dried flowers and seeds to make something that grows! Explore colour and texture in this messy craft!

Recommended for learners age 7+ Max 14



Rocket Launch

Examine why what goes up, must come down and discover what happens when gravity makes an impact! Build and launch rockets to see how how they soar! Experiment with wing and cone shape to see how small changes can make big differences. This program requires outdoor space.

Recommended for learners age 6+ Max 20

Oozing Oobleck

Oobleck is a classic science experiment that's perfect for entertaining both kids and adults. Explore how this non-newtonian fluid can act like both a solid and a liquid! Use your oozing oobleck to learn about Ph balance with acids and bases.

Recommended for learners age 8+ Max 18



Super Slime

Turn your space into a slime lab. You will make slime from scratch while experimenting to create the perfect slime recipe. You can decorate your slimes however you like using colourants, glitter, and more. Please note: this program includes the use of Borax.

Recommended for learners age 6+ Max 18

Our museum interpreter will come to you for a fun session of sharing. and learning. Get social, share your stories and explore history!

With our collection of touchable artifacts we will explore Lincoln's history hands-on. Participants will engage with original and replica objects from the collection and respond to them creatively and collaboratively. Through facilitated discussion we can explore how life has changed and what has stayed the same through the centuries!

Cost

Creativity and STEAM Workshops: \$15/person. Program bookings require a minimum of 12 participants. Bookings with less than 12 participants will be charged based on this minimum (\$84).

Museum Memories Talks: \$100/visit. There is no minimum or maximum participation for the history talks.

All workshops and talks take approx. 1.5 hours

Payments

Cancellations
